The Board went through the Budget Review and Trustee Gareau moved to raise the hourly cost from \$15 an hour to \$20 and hour for the Board of Review members.

It was discussed that the bike path from Wells to Gladstone we don't send the \$1,000 to them but put it toward other line items.

The Delta County Solid Waste cost has gone up and we decided to add \$900 to vouchers and \$100 to the Gladstone Public Library.

The items for Election Supplies has risen to a higher cost. The voting machines we had to budget \$3,000 for each precinct and we have 4.

Roads will stay the same at \$175,000.

The Street Lights will have to be raised and we will discuss this with MTA to find out the right procedure.
